

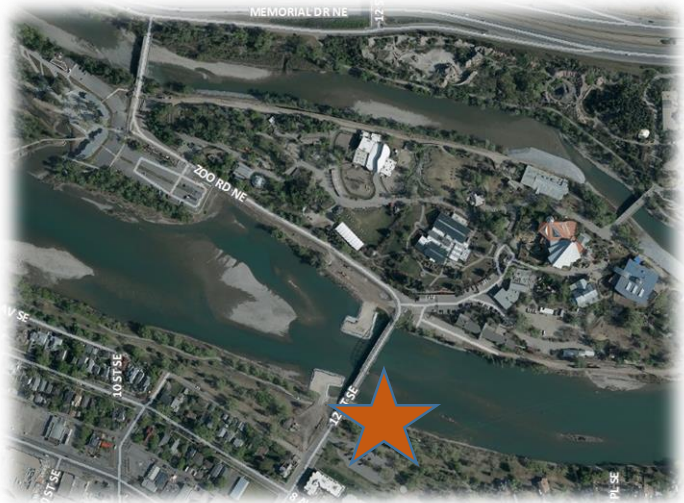

Calgary River Access Strategy Boat Ramp Development

INGLEWOOD BRIDGE

Bow River Trout as a member of Calgary River Users Alliance has committed to assist with the community support of this new river access site. Inglewood is critical as it will be the only egress point suitable for drift boats take-out downstream of **West Baker Park** before **Harvie Passage**. The Inglewood river access site will allow drift boats to access the portion of the Bow river that is upstream of the weir.



The location of this new boat ramp will be approximately where the old 12 Street S.E. bridge once stood. This site would require all components of an access site including a boat ramp. Parking will be on-site or adjacent roads would also be available as well as garbage cans, benches, tables, and portable toilets.



This work will be coordinated with various City of Calgary business units as the new bridge is completed in 2018.

The new boat ramp is expected completed in 2019.

The total cost of the river access site development is \$ 520,000 with the City of Calgary asking for community support of \$75,000.

Bow River Trout will be applying for community grants in 2018 and will fundraise for the balance of our commitment.
